Choose <u>ONLY ONE</u> of the following activities to submit:

- 1. There have been numerous doubts and criticisms regarding the preservation and divine origin of the Quran. Critics have raised several objections against it. Please list at least eight claims made by critics and their corresponding answers.
- 2. The compilation of the Quran is an incredible feat that spanned many years and involved a complex process consisting of numerous stages. This process started during the time of Prophet Muhammad and has been passed down to us in the form of a book. Can you please explain the various stages of the compilation process in detail?
- **3.** Kindly provide a detailed explanation of the different types of Tafsir, the Tafsir al-Ma'thoor and Tafsir al-Ra'y, and expound on the methods of Quranic exegesis, accompanied with relevant examples.
- **4.** What do the terms "Makki" and "Madani" refer to in the Qur'an? What are the benefits of understanding the differences between these two types of verses? Additionally, please provide examples of how knowledge of the science of Makki and Madani verses is crucial to comprehending Islamic law (Hukm) and its principles.

You can present your work by one of the following methods:

- A Word/PDF file; word limit is 400-600 words; font: Times New Roman, font size: 14, spacing is 1.5 lines, headings are bold, the text is justified; adding references in footnotes or at the end is very recommended.
- 2- A PowerPoint presentation is at most ten slides; font: Arial, font size: 24-28; be creative in presenting your work and summarizing your findings; mention your references.
- 3- Record a (5-15 minute) video of yourself talking about your research findings; make sure you mention some references. The video should be HD quality (the minimum is 720p).
