 Technically: it is sayings and actions start with Takbeer and ends with Tasleem (often).

Times of Salah (Prayer Times)



	Begins	Ends
Zuhr	When sun passes through its meridian (descends from its zenith)	when the shadow of an object becomes the same size of the object beside the shadow that was cast at zenith.
Asr	when the object"s shadow equals its length in addition to the length of its shadow at the time of zawāl	when the sun sets.
Maghrib	when the sun completely sets	when all redness disappears from the western horizon.
Ishaa'	From the setting of the red horizon - when all redness disappears from the western horizon	when early dawn appears (true dawn)
Fajr/Subh	from early dawn	sunrise



Pray Sunnah Qabliyyah

To pray in the 1st row

Make rows straight with no gaps

Raising Hands in Takbeerat-ul-

Raising hands at four places

Put the right palm on the left

Looking at the place of Sujood

Recitation of Duaa' Istiftaah

Ta'awwudth (quietly)

Ta'meen (after Fatihah)

Recitation of Surah in the first two rak'as

Make the first rak'ah longer than the second

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Zikr of Ruku'

Glory (and praise) be to my Lord Almighty

My hearing, sight, bones, brain, sinews, and whatever my legs carry are humbled before You, the lord of worlds)."

Zikr of Sujood

Glory (and praise) be to my Lord Most High

"Allahumma laka sajadtu wa bika aamantu wa laka aslamtu wa anta Rabbi, sajada wajhi lilladhi khalaqahu wa sawwarahu wa shaqqa sam'ahu wa basarahu, tabarak Allahu ahsanul-khaliqin (O Allah, to You I have prostrated and in You I have believed and to You I have submitted, and You are my Lord. My face has prostrated to the One Who created it and formed it and brought forth its hearing and sight. Blessed be Allah the best of Creators.)"

Zikr of Iftirash



(Allahumma ighfir li, warhamni, wajburni, warfa'ni, warzuqni, wahdini, wa'aafeni, wa'fu 'anni). 'O Allah! Forgive me, have mercy on me, help me, raise me in status, grant me sustenance, guide me, heal me, and pardon me'"

Istighfar (3 times)

Ayat Al-Kursi

33 times (SubhanAllah, Alhamdulillah, Allahu Akbar)

Say: 'La ilaha illa Allah...'

Say: 'Allahuma anta assalam ...'

Say: 'Allahumma la mani' lima a'tayt ...'

Say: 'Ashhadu alla ilaha illa Allah ArRahman...'

Say: 'Allahumma a'enni 'ala zikrek ...'

Specific Azkar for Fajr and Maghrib

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None has the right to be worshipped but Allah alone, He has no partner, His is the dominion and His is the praise, and He is Able to do all things. O Allah, there is none who can withhold what You give, and none may give what You have withheld, and the might of the mighty person cannot benefit him against You.

O Allah, protect me from Hell

The Disliked Acts – Situations



To pray when one needs to answer to the calls of nature or pass gas

To pray when one is extremely hungry for food and it has been served

To pray while covering face

To pray with the head uncovered

To pray in Isbaal or with cloth has pictures or not covering shoulders

The Disliked Acts – Missing Sunan

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Not reciting Takbeerat Intiqaal

Not reciting the duaas of ruku', sujud, I'tidal, and sitting

Not reciting the surah after Fatiha in the 1st and 2nd rak'aas

To lower the head during ruku'

Not touching the ground with nose in Sujood

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To raise your voice with recitation or duaa when praying with Imam

To recite aloud in sirree and soft in jahree salah

The Disliked Acts – Specific Actions AYAAT ILM ACADEMY Strucks Filt Ladge (Volume)

To look towards the sky

To look on either side by turning the neck without any necessity

To spit or blow the nose

To stand on one leg or place the one in front and the other behind or join both together

To crack the fingers or intertwine them

Folding sleeves or putting hair together in salah

The Disliked Acts - Specific Actions

Removing dust from head or making the ground even or raising one leg

Shaking right and left in salah

Putting finger in mouth or nose for no reason

Sitting like camels, looking like foxes, sitting like wild animals, and crow peck

Pray in the same pace of the Imam

The Disliked Acts - Place of Salah



Pray in washrooms

Pray at graveyard

Pray in garbage place

Pray in churches and synagogues

Pray where camels drink

Pray in valley with likelihood of flood coming

Pray facing someone who is facing him

Nullifiers of Salah



To leave out any integral or condition of Salah

Hadath (ritual impurity)

Impurity falling on the body or clothes (if not removed immediately w/o carrying)

Exposing of the 'awrah if it was not covered immediately

Intentionally uttering one or two letters which can be clearly understood (or to laugh aloud)

To eat purposely something that invalidates fasting

To forgetfully eat a lot

Three consecutive motions even if by mistake

Nullifiers of Salah



Extra movement that is contrary to the habit of a sane person (extra jump)

An excessive strike of the hand

To intentionally add an extra physical integral of salah

To precede the imam in two physical integrals of salah

To delay with the two integrals without an excuse

The intention of terminating the salah by suspending its termination on a foreign action

By doubting its termination
